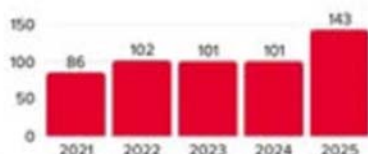

TALKIN' ...FISHIN'.....BEAT THE HEAT

Although we don't plan to go out and fish in the heat, but as unpredictable as our summers are, some days just turn it on after we drop the anchor for a days fishing. Shade on these days is just as important as keeping up your fluid intake, so consider making or buying a shade cloth shelter. Depending on the density of the fabric either 50%, 75%, or 90% it can give you UV protection up to a certain degree, but this isn't a replacement for protective clothing or lotion blockers, however it is effective when used in conjunction with each other and following the product usage guidelines.

Advantages of this product are: 1. Cut and sewn to customize your boat, 2. colors are available, and 3. can be attached in sections not only one piece. 4. Rolls or folds away for easy storage. 5. Independent or attached to your Bimini framework. 6. Velcro panels or sewn and folded edges with eyelets or tabs (hook and loop) to 50mm wide. 7. Allows a breeze and some rain through the weave. 8. Resistant to rot.

Some ingenuity is required as to how to install your shade cloth cover, customize it to suit your boat by including H.D. electrical orange pvc tubing gives the assembly flexibility and some strength as pole supports. Sleeve the sides of the canopy like curtain and insert the pvc like curtain rods, insert into your unused rod holders, this will give you easy fitting and sliding adjustment like a pram hood. If you're going to fit out like an annexe or awning then adjustable height aluminium paint roller poles will do a purpose fit job. If neither of these doesn't suit you'll need to cover the open spaces around you to gain shaded areas. Time to be a genius, nothing is more uncomfortable than sitting out in the midday sun in a boat, when everything is heating up around you.



Stay cool and dry, and remember to Slip, Slop, Slap and cover up.
